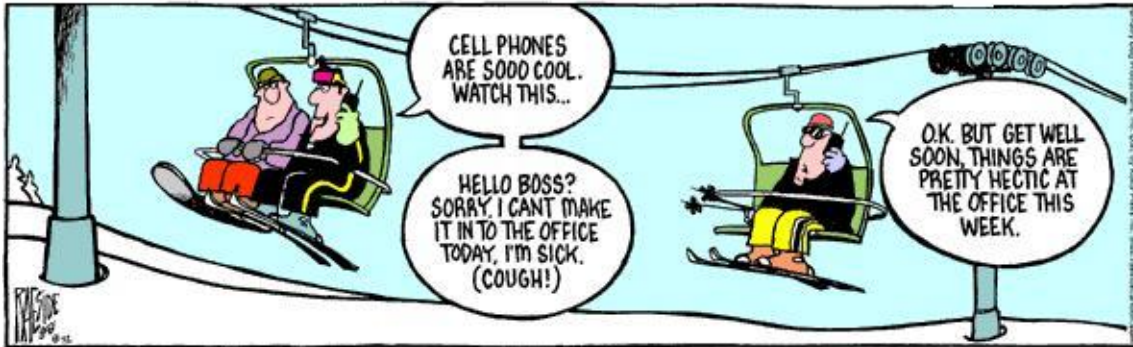

ATTENTION ALL FAGOWEE RACERS & WANNABE FAGOWEE RACERS!!!

Both Larry Foote and Mike Gumbish want to give you a chance to reduce your race fees.

It is very simple; all you need to do is ski race 10 times or snowboard race 9 times. If you do both, the number of races you need is just 10 combined. (Combined ski and snowboard races are 26, so this is the best deal). The qualifier does not count.

Yes, if you race the minimum number of races required, you could get your race fees covered by either Larry or Mike.

The rules are simple: You race at least the minimum number of required races. Your name will go into a hat. At the end of the season, four names will be pulled out of the hat.

Two names will be sponsored by Larry, and two will be sponsored by Mike. The first two names will be eligible to have their race fees covered up to \$100 Larry or Mike. If there is any money left the balance goes to the third and fourth names pulled.

As you know, the club pays a percentage of the race fees you are charged by CMSC. You are then charged by the Fagowees for the balanced owed. It is this balanced that you owe that could be covered by either Larry or Mike up to \$100 in this 'sponsored' drawing. We pay max \$100, if you owe more than \$100 you are still responsible for that amount over \$100. If you owe less than \$100 the un-used balance gets used by the third and fourth name pulled.

Such a deal, just for racing!

So, get your races in, get your name in the hat, & get sponsored!!!

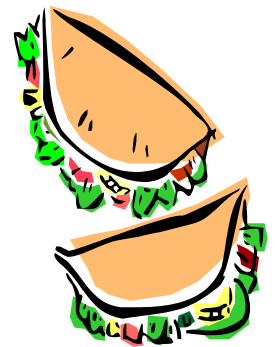
