Whistler Blackcomb Ski Resort: "#1 Three Years Running!"

No other resort offers so much variety. Whistler Resort is suitable for all types of skiers and snowboarders, from first-timers to extreme riders who want to ride hair-raising steeps.

What to do in and around the Whistler Blackcomb area if you are not a skier or boarder? A sample of other Whistler winter activities includes snowmobiling, zip-lining, dog sledding, fondue dinners, tubing, ice-skating, and day spas, and of course there's the famous Whistler shopping.
