### My Fellow Fagowees

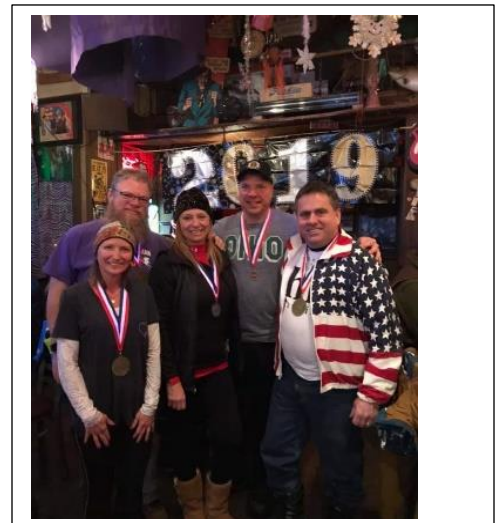
It is getting cold outside! Skiing conditions have been great. I hope you have been getting outside and getting in some winter activities.

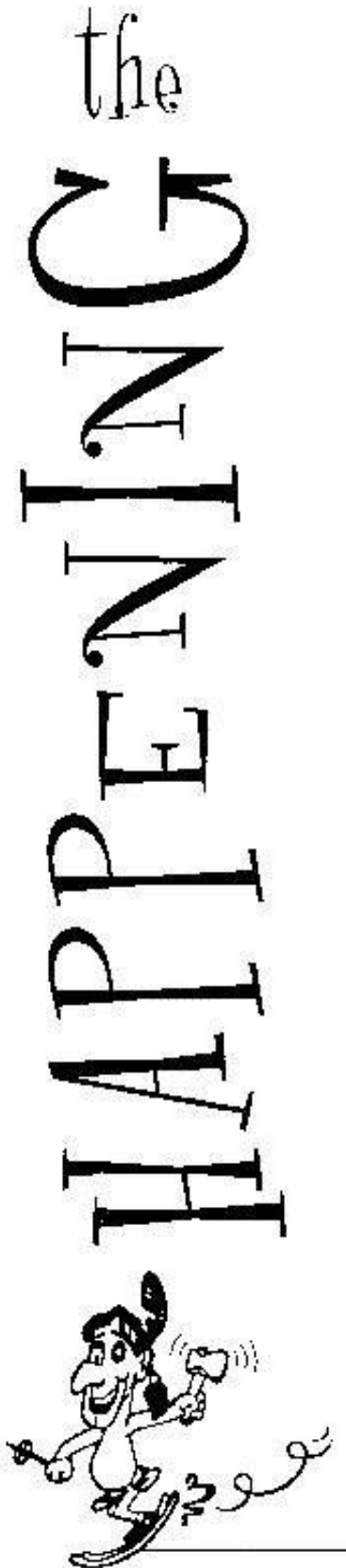
Tony T. and Gary K. will be hosting a bus trip to Holimont on Wednesday, February 13. To top off the trip Tony will be having his famous Après cookout.

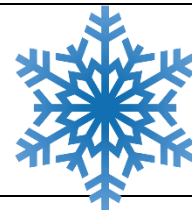
