SYNOPSIS OF THE METRO CUP

Under tropical conditions at Punderson State Park Golf Course, twenty-three Fagowees battled for their first Metro Cup Championship trophy, in the closest competition to date. Congratulations to all participants, who fell just short of their championship goal, edged by Hi-Rise Ski Club, finishing second by five points.

Team Captain Erik F's controversial and divisive strategy to limit participants in team events, and maximize entrants in singles (medalist) play, was validated by an exceptionally strong showing in both the Male and Female Medalist events. Coupled with a second place finish by Esther and Mitch in Coed Scramble, third place finish by Rob and Neal in Best Ball, and a fourth place finish by the lone Four Person Scramble team, the team total exceeded expectation, nearly besting Hi-Rises 29 member team, but secured second place (by 6 points) over Continental Ski Cub team which included 23 participants, just like us.

Led by a first-place finish by Patti Matzinger, the six member Women's' Medalist team scored 22 points, nearly half of the available points, and led all other Fagowees teams in scoring.

The seven Men's' Medalists more than held their own, scoring seventeen points, buoyed by Tom C's third place finish. Although participation in Medalist play was an unpopular decision, the spirit of team play in the face of tough conditions and competition shined through. There is strength in numbers.

The torrid heat, fast greens, late day thunder, lightning, and monsoon rains proved a true test of golf and stamina. Everyone survived and enjoyed the post-golf dinner and awards ceremony. Our own Mark Hyatt was lucky off the course, with his double raffle winnings.

Individual skill shots were won by the following from the Fagowees: # 9 pin shot Karen Fashimpaur, #14 long drive women Yvonne Daycak, and # 10 pin shot Ester Daniels.

Congratulations to the perennial winner, Hi-Rise Ski Club, and especially to Dr. Bob and his crew for again organizing a fun and exciting event.

Your participation in next years' Metro Cup, and all golf events, is welcomed and encouraged, regardless of your golf skill. Changes for the 2020 Metro Cup venue, scoring, and team events are open for suggestion, and will be discussed in an upcoming organizational meeting involving all Team captains.
